About the Tour:

Hermanus is synonymous with shore-based whale watching. Its sheltered coves attract marine mammals during mating and calving seasons, making it one of the best land-based whale-watching locations globally! Southern Right whales migrate from their icy feeding grounds off Antarctica to warmer climates, reaching South Africa around late May/June. These majestic creatures congregate in Hermanus' shallow, sandy coves to deliver one of nature's most remarkable spectacles.

Visitors can witness Southern Right whales breaching, spy hopping, and sailing (using their tails to catch the wind) in Walker Bay. Their lack of dorsal fins and mostly black colour make them a truly spectacular sight to behold.

Beyond whales, Hermanus offers a range of other activities and attractions. With diverse floral kingdoms, mountain paths, pristine beaches, and secluded forests, Hermanus captivates travellers seeking natural beauty and relaxation.
